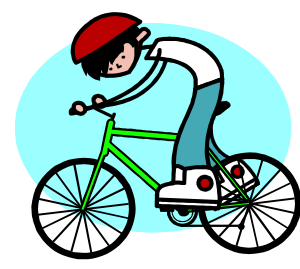
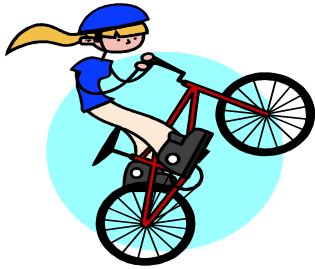


# 4-H Bikes for Tykes Junior Mechanics Program

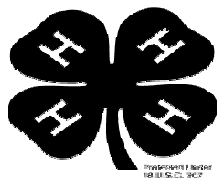


**Who:** Adult Volunteers and youth ages 13 and up
