Share The Road MOTORISTS

Floridians have an active outdoor lifestyle, so be prepared to **Share The Road** with bicyclists and pedestrians.

- ➔ Bicycles have a legal right to ride on the street as well as the sidewalk.
- ➔ Provide at least 3 feet of space between your vehicle and the bicyclist when passing.
- ➔ Yield to bicyclists and pedestrians at crosswalks and when they are crossing unmarked intersections.
- ➔ Look for bicyclists before making a turn.
- ➔ Look for bicyclists and pedestrians before exiting a parking space or driveway.
- ➔ Only honk in emergencies.

Share The Road

BICYCLISTS

- ➔ There are a lot of car in Southwest Florida, so be prepared to Share the Road courteously with motorists.
- ➔ Obey all traffic laws, including stopping at STOP signs or red lights.
- ➔ Ride in the same direction as other traffic.
- ➔ Take the lane when traveling at the speed of traffic and ride just to the right and single file when the road is wide enough.
- ➔ Allow motorists to pass when they are lined up behind you.
- ➔ Be visible – wear bright colors.
- ➔ Use hand signals and be predictable.
- ➔ Wear a helmet and make sure your bike has lights.
